## WORK SESSION MINUTES

February 22, 2021

The Mayor and Council met February 22, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. for a work session at the Boaz Senior Center.

Members Present: Council Members David Ellis, Josh Greer, Johnny Willis, Jeff Sims, Mike Matthews, and Mayor David Dyar.


Member Absent: None.

The following topics were discussed:

1. Each Department Head was given time to talk about what was going on in their department.
  - Fire Chief Jeff Beck reported that there was a house fire on Friday and it is still undetermined at this time the cause but no one was hurt. The new Brush truck is still in Decatur. The new Weather Warn system will be installed in a week or two. Mayor Dyar asked if there would be testing done on the sirens. Chief Beck said that they did silent testing of the system but they could start doing audible testing. Council Member Ellis asked if there were any dead areas in the city limits where you could not here the sirens. Chief Beck said the only place he could think of was in the Beulah Road area. Council Member Ellis asked him to check on pricing to get one in that area.
  - Street Superintendent Kenny Smith reported that the Bruce Road drainage project was complete. He stated that Triple J Construction still needed to do some curb replacement and fix some drainage issues at Rustic Hills Subdivision before that project is completed. A cross drain will be replaced tomorrow on Lindo Drive. The Town of Sardis will be doing tree trimming on Rhoden Avenue to Church Street in Sardis tomorrow.
  - Building Inspector Nick Borden reported that there was still some details to iron out with the new zoning ordinance and he was meeting with Kelley Taft Thursday. He stated that Houston Jenkins was in attendance about a change order for the ADA Compliant Inmate Walkway project. Houston gave the Mayor and Council a handout of the proposed changes to the scope of project.
  - Mayor Dyar thanked the Boaz Police Department for the good job they did at the incident at Jack's with the bank robbery suspects. Council Member Willis stated he appreciated the way Police Chief Gaskin handle the situation and the statement that he put on social media.
