A visit has been scheduled for May to visit the Pierce plant to go over the specification for the new fire truck. Chief Beck reminded everyone of the monthly weather siren testing on the first Wednesday of the month at 10 am. He also had a company come check to see if every siren was working correctly and they are working on an estimate to upgrade the sirens.
