WORK SESSION MINUTES

June 14, 2021

The Mayor and Council met June 14, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. for a work session at the Boaz Senior Center.

Members Present: Council Members David Ellis, Josh Greer, Johnny Willis, Mike Matthews, and Mayor Pro Tem Jeff Sims.

Member Absent: Mayor David Dyar.

The following topics were discussed:

1. Department Head Reports

- Police Chief Josh Gaskin stated that Donohoo Chevrolet should have some Tahoes in by July 1st. Michael Turner Jr. and Will Smith will be starting the police academy in August. There is a job posted now for a police officer job.
- Fire Chief Jeff Beck reported that the check engine light keeps coming on in Engine 1 and they have had multiple mechanics look at it. They carried it to Emergency Equipment Professionals, Inc. last week and they said that the engine needs to be replaced. He stated he would send the Council the quote.
- Street Superintendent Kenny Smith said he had been talking with the railroad company about refurbishing the railroad crossings. The railroad company has 4 people maintaining 125 miles of railroad in our area. High Rail is the company they recommended to buy the materials from to fix the crossings. This would be a 2-3 day project on each crossing. They would create pedestrian crossings as well.
- Economic/Personnel Director Kerry Walls state that the City had 7 job openings.
- Parks and Recreation Director Sonja Hard reported that Rec State started this weekend, Camp Boaz has started coming to the pool, and the Swim Team is practicing. Men's Church League is also starting.
- Senior Center Susan Duvall reported that the Senior Center was open and that they have been having 45 to 50 a day in attendance. ALDOT called saying that our 7 passenger van was ready to pick up. There will be a live radio remote at the Senior Center on Friday from 8-10 am.
- City Clerk/Treasurer Jill Bright stated that the audit has started.
